**PARISH COUNCIL’S AUGUST SNIPPETS:**

- From Treasurer: “**Our average monthly income** for Jan - June 2019 was **\$17,082** – average offertory **\$9,973**. **Offertory for July** was **\$9,475**. **Average monthly expenses** were **\$15,421**
- Average **surplus** each month is around **\$1,661**, which is reliant on income other than offertory”.

- **A reminder** that we all need to be aware of our **fire plans** in the event of an emergency – the plans are on the notice boards, & advise safe exit & gathering sites. Our Fire Extinguishers are checked each half-year.
- **Unfete figures** not yet finalized.
- **Prayer Chain Ministry** - Sadly, after decades of faithful service, Gwyn Limon has stepped down from coordinating the ministry. Rhonda has agreed to take it on – **Thank you Rhonda!**
- **SUN OCT 13 (after lunch)**. Fr Steve Astill, (Moruya’s new catholic priest) advises they plan a short ceremony at Bodalla’s St Edmunds to honour the restoration of their stained-glass windows & the sainting of Richard Hooker, followed by a car procession to All Saints for a short ceremony, complete with choir, and refreshments. More details coming.
- **Mainly Music** Numbers have grown again, with approximately 12 children and 8 carers including Dads, Mums, Grandpa’s and Grandma’s – an answer to prayer!
- **Youth Group** - 20 – 25 young people attend. A **leadership planning day** is being held on **Sat 31 Aug**. Then a “**mini-camp**” at Dalmeny Hall called “Above & Beyond” on **Sat 16 Nov**, 8.30 – 6.30pm. “Please continue to pray for children & families to commit to coming & helping out at Mainly Music, Youth Group & Messy Church....” - Mandy.
