From COMBINED REFUGEE ACTION GROUP: “In May the National Council of Churches, the Australian Churches Refugee Taskforce & various Jewish, Muslim & Christian faiths issued a statement calling on the Federal Parliament to provide a “Jubilee” or amnesty for the people seeking refuge who have been subject to Australia’s offshore processing policies for six years. We are asking faith communities/faith-based schools to demonstrate support for this statement by sending a letter, using (our) template as a guide, to each of the Prime Minister, Opposition Leader & your local Member of Parliament.” (Statement & template copies available at rear.) 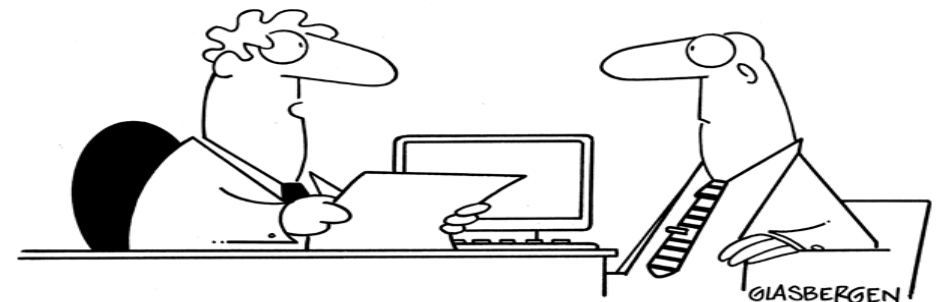
