**SNIPPETS from Australia's Christian Heritage:** *“The arrival of Samuel Leigh in NSW in 1816 (till 1831) was to open a new chapter in Australia's history. Hitherto the spread of the Christian faith depended largely upon the fixed ministries of the Anglican chaplains whose many commitments restricted the extent of their preaching. By establishing a wide preaching circuit...in the Wesleyan tradition, Leigh introduced a new missionary era... ‘What can one missionary do in such a country as this? Yet I have seen many penitential tears... Pray that I may be filled with faith in Christ, and with a burning zeal for the spread of His gospel.’ (S Leigh) – Ian H Murray, Australian Christian Life from 1788 “*

*I do suggest though that we begin reading, for ourselves, the Revelation, the Apocalypse, a word that has been widely used during the fire crisis. It means revelation or revealing, and of course refers to the revealing of Christ at the end of the age. It is meant as a focus of hope not fear, but the popular feeling given to the word at the moment is fear. I think also that it is important to think of it as something like a dream, and not be too ready to interpret the symbols but rather let them wash over us so that understanding comes from the broadest sense first.”* David & Angela.

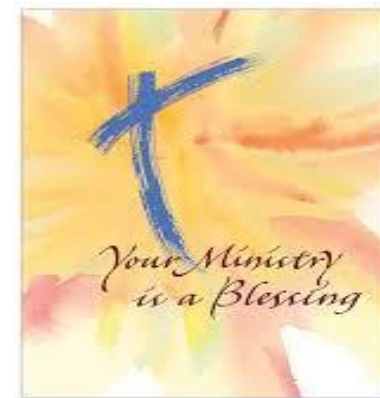
