**NEWS from the TINGLE’S:** “.... This week I was reminded of the spiritual battle we are in and the reassurance we have as we hold firm to our Lord. One student was relating to me the story of how he changed his name - When he was 12yrs old he fell and bumped his head a couple of times. His family were very worried after these unfortunate accidents and they went to the temple. The monks at the temple said that his name should be changed so that he would have better luck in the future. Another student told me of the trouble that had come upon his uncle and his family because of a curse that was put on them. There was an acknowledgement that there are powers of evil at work in this world, but unfortunately no knowledge of the One who is *“far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.”* (Eph 1:21). I'm glad that I have the opportunity to talk further with these students about this. **Please pray for these conversations, and pray for the many others unaware of the One who is able to give them freedom from this fear and bondage.**

J, one of our new brothers in the Lord has experienced this freedom, started coming to the Centre about 8 months ago - it was just a chance meeting as he was visiting his old professors on a day off from work. On this day he met one of our teachers at the university & took up the invitation to come to our Wednesday night dinner. From there he started attending our Wednesday & Friday events, enjoying socialising and practicing English. During (our) conversation he shared his difficult childhood, where he had to mostly take care of himself, because of the mental health & alcohol problems of his carers. He felt he could never believe that there was a God that really cared because of these experiences. A couple of months ago he had an experience that really shook him up & he felt that God had protected his life, & others around him. He took up the invitation to visit a local church with one of our teachers & after a number of weeks and conversations with the pastor he put his trust in Jesus. Praise God!!
