"DO WE NEED REVIVAL TODAY? – Aziza Green explores the what, why, how and when of Revival" - summarised from ETERNITY, Winter 2023.

- \* "Revivals are very dramatic, often involve emotion." Jonathon Edwards.
- \* "Revival is a concerted assault on the powers of darkness there is a spiritual dimension"
- \* The implication is that the church, believers, were asleep. Tired. At times, exhausted."
- \* "...Through revivals, God equips us for a purpose and to get on with it. Once we are refreshed, we can start again." Prof Stuart Piggin.
- \* "Revival is about bringing what was dead back to life" Pastor Jemima Varughese
- \* "The 1902 Illawarra Revival, (2735 conversions, 15% of population) showed that debts were repaid, less children were born outside marriage, mine horses couldn't work as they no longer understand the miners' commands because they had stopped swearing.... and showed a decline in national crime and immorality... the same showed in Australia's 1959 Billy Graham Crusades" Prof Stuart Piggin.
- \* 1939 Pinnacle Pocket (FNQ) Revival equipped scores of aboriginal Pastors to ministry.
- \* The 1979 Elcho Island Revival "empowered First Nations people... to survive & thrive."
