**ABM Pew Sheet Reflection 2019:** *“Love: Today we find Jesus quizzing St Peter over whether he truly loves him – fair enough given his thrice-denial of Christ before a rooster’s crowing had come home to roost. Jesus’ words to Peter reveal his instructions to the ordained ministry & to the Church more generally. The lambs are to be fed, the sheep are to be tended & fed. Pastoral care is to be at the heart of the Church. Pope Francis reminds clergy that they need to ‘smell like their sheep’ by working among them. This can be broadened to anyone in lay ministry: getting out there & loving others through quality pastoral care is what we are called to do.”*

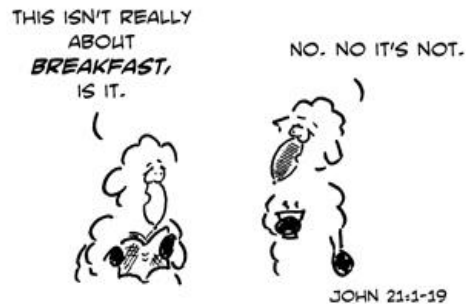

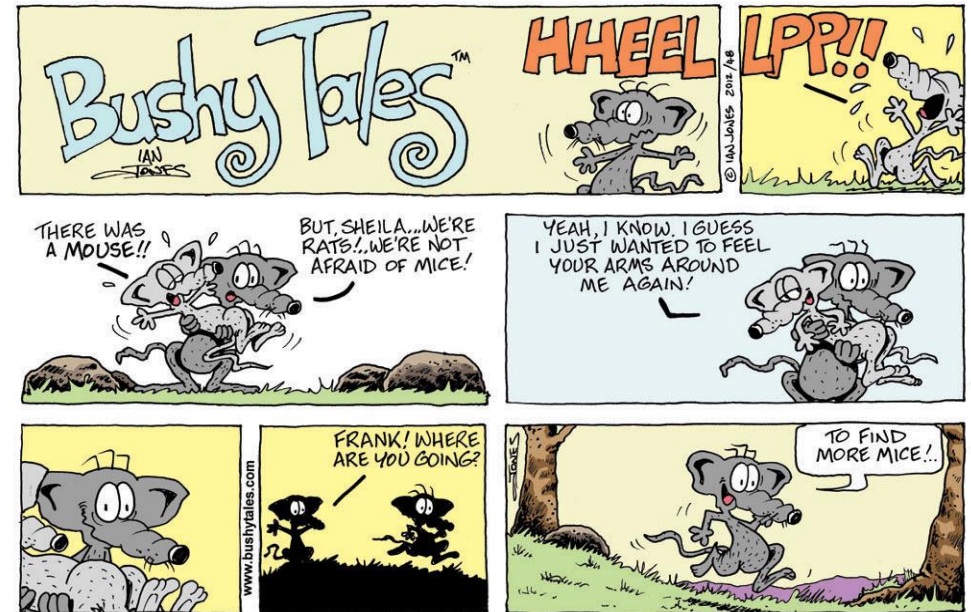
