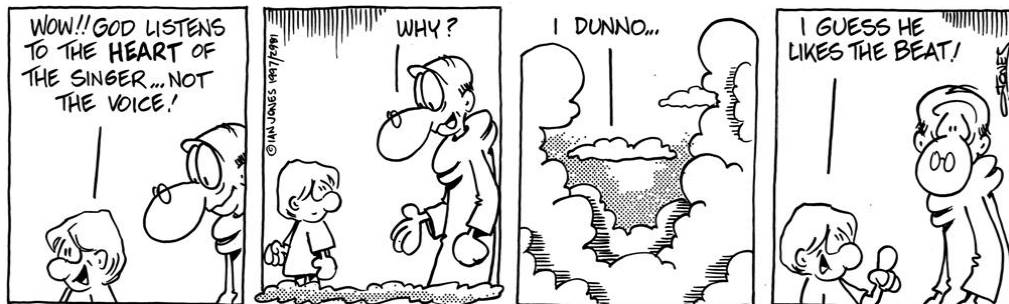

**“...the Spirit of God moved....**(Gen 1-2, KJV) – Christ’s disciples left everything to follow somebody they didn’t begin to comprehend. They dreamed of a Messiah who would establish a kingdom to overthrow Rome, so His crucifixion blew their minds. So did His resurrection, because they had to preach a message that would cost them their lives. Sometimes they didn’t know what to make of Jesus: ‘...the disciples saw Him walking on the sea...’*“it is a spirit,” they cried out.* (Matt 14:26 KJV). When He ate with them on the shore following His resurrection, *‘None...dared ask Him, “Who are You?” knowing that it was the Lord* (John 21:12 NKJV).
