**From COMBINED REFUGEE ACTION GROUP:** “In May this year, the National Council of Churches, the Australian Churches Refugee Taskforce & various Jewish, Muslim & Christian faiths issued a statement calling on the Federal Parliament to provide a “Jubilee” or amnesty for the people seeking refuge who have been subject to Australia’s offshore processing policies for the past six years.
