“There shall be showers of blessing; oh, that today they might fall, Now as to God we’re confessing, now as on Jesus we call...

Refrain: Showers of blessing, Showers of blessing we need:

Mercy-drops round us are falling, but for the showers we plead.” - DW Whittle, 1883:

“A complaining fast won’t just make everyone around you happier...you’ll experience more joy, peace, success and positive relationships.” (Jon Gordon – TWFT)

So instead of complaining when things go wrong: Practise gratitude. Giving thanks for three blessings every day energises you and makes you feel happier. It’s impossible to be grateful and negative at the same time. - TWFT
