ABM - TWO EMERGENCY APPEALS were launched During May: one for the Ahli Hospital in Gaza, owned & operated by the Anglican Diocese of Jerusalem, & the other for the Action by Churches Together (ACT) Alliance response to the COVID-19 crisis in India.

The new Archbishop of Jerusalem, the Right Rev'd Hosam Naoum, has called for **donations** to provide fuel & medical supplies for the **Ahli Hospital in Gaza**, which is treating those with severe wounds, including moderate to severe burns, in their burns wards. They are also providing support to traumatised women & children.

In India, local ACT partners are supporting people who are sick at home or quarantined, by providing them with cash to buy medicines & other emergency needs. They will also be raising more awareness in communities about infection prevention & control, including information on vaccines, & will be working with churches & other faith leaders to this end.
