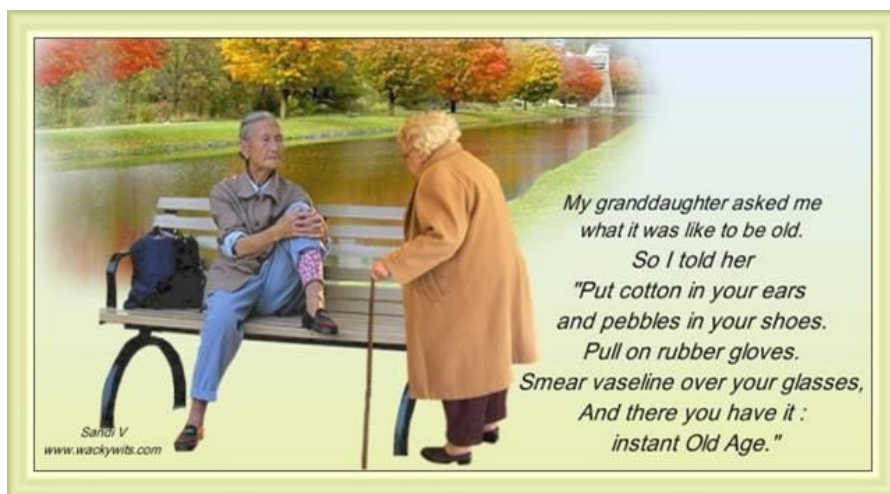

**More Thoughts** from **The FORGIVENESS CROSS, MEMORY MOUNTAIN, NT** - Vision Radio.

**Ray Martin:** "Earlier on, I had some serious doubts about the Cross, in terms of whether it was wanted locally or whether white fellas were once again giving black fellas a bit of God. I came and spoke to the people, **and clearly, they wanted a wad of God.** So I joined the board of [Walk A While](#), and you look down the road, and there's the Cross, which is amazing.

If you were a betting man, you'd have to say, it wasn't going to happen. The black fellas worked with Ken Duncan building it. They worked in 45-degree temperatures, and they took that steel up there and helped build it. There are very few Aboriginal success stories apart from sport, so **to get something like this where the community got together and had a dream and to see an Aboriginal dream realised, it's really important.'**
