Have any of you been experiencing COVID fatigue? We certainly have been. This season just keeps dragging on (case numbers go up, then come down, places open up, then close again, hopes and plans continually needing to be changed, waiting...) When will it stop?

- **Please pray** for the **COVID situation** here in Chiang Mai. The daily cases are higher than ever before (492 for the province yesterday) & the girls' school has gone back to online learning because of 17+ cases in the school. Yet at the same time, since Thailand relies heavily on tourism, the country has opened up this month for tourists to arrive.
- **So please pray** for things to be managed well & for the overflowing hospitals to cope. Thankfully, we have been able to remain healthy. Matt, Alisa & Maya are now fully vaccinated & Lucy gets her first shot tomorrow hopefully.



**- Join us in rejoicing** in God's goodness- last month Lucy & Jemima made an important step in their faith journey & were **baptised!! Please pray** for these precious girls to grow in the Lord & to keep their eyes on Him as they navigate their journeys.

- We have opened up the Centre again and are just starting slowly to get some **new students** signing up. We are doing online and in-person classes now. We are praying for God to bring more students to study with us and for the opportunity to gain momentum, since there has been a lot of time spent only doing online classes.

God has been speaking to me through the story of Jesus walking on the water- the disciples were rowing hard & struggling against the wind & the waves, Jesus spoke to them, **"Don't be afraid. Take courage. I am here."** He climbed into the boat & the wind stopped.

*How often are we struggling & striving, making plans, trying to solve problems & we just need to invite Jesus into the boat? He is sufficient, he brings calm, & we can trust 'the out of our control things' to Him who is in control. I think this is a lesson we all need to keep relearning.*
