DID YOU KNOW? TIPS for BETTER RECYCLING: Garden hoses, Christmas lights, cables, and similar wire types are not recyclable through the kerbside bin.

All types of extended wires, cables, and coat hangers should not enter the MRF regardless of the material. Because of how the machine is designed, cables and wires risk getting tangled up between gears and other moving parts which can clog the machine and cause damage. - Cleanaway
