

BCA BOXES: 'Currently, **one of the most significant challenges for BCA is sourcing workers with the right balance of calling & experience to what are often remote places.**

There are strategies that we continue to work on, but ultimately the answer to this challenge is found in the following verse: "(Jesus said) *Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field.*". This is where each of us have a pivotal role to play, regularly & urgently asking the Lord to send out workers into this vast harvest. To encourage you to be disciplined in this activity let me suggest this modest action that I heard about in another context. Each morning most of us either put on the kettle or turn on the coffee machine. **Could we take**

that small daily action as a reminder to stop for a moment & ask for God to raise up workers? What might possibly happen if tens of thousands of prayers were offered each morning as the water boiled or the coffee machine warmed up?' - Greg Harris, BCA National Director.
