ABM PEW SHEET REFLECTION 2018: *“The beginning of the end or the begetting of a new beginning? What we witness in Mark’s apocalyptic Gospel passage heralds not only the actual, physical destruction of the Temple of Jerusalem itself, but also the end of the then-world order. Jesus advises caution, dampening over-zealousness and discouraging overreaction to various signs. Before the End is nigh, the Gospel must be spread to all nations. Change, although ordained from above, must emerge from within through the transformation of hearts.”*

Last weekend, we elected our 11th Diocesan BISHOP – The Reverend Dr Mark Short. *“...He is currently National Director of Bush Church Aid, working in partnership with 17 Anglican Diocese & other Christian organisations across Australia to support gospel workers in remote & regional areas. He holds a Bachelor of Theology with Honours from Moore College awarded in 1997, & was ordained a Deacon in 1996 & a Priest in 1997 in Goulburn.....*

.....As Bishop, Reverend Dr Mark Short will assume the oversight of our 62 parishes & mission districts, eight schools & significant community agencies such as Anglicare & St Mark’s National Theological Centre. 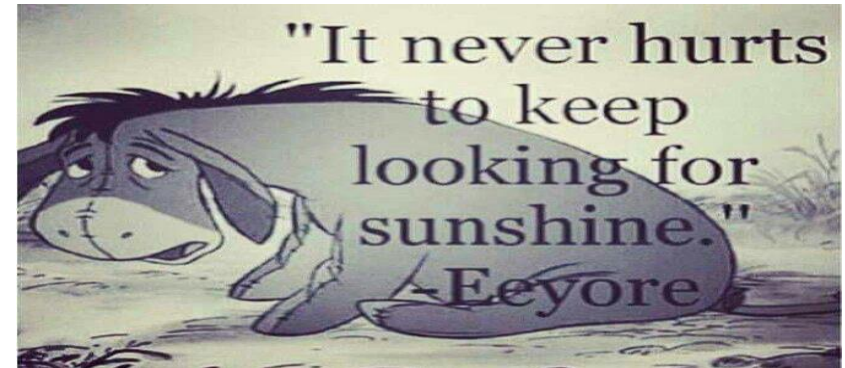
