ABM Pew Sheet Reflections 2023: "At God's command, Moses and Joshua went up into the mountain of God. It appears, however, that only Moses entered the cloud, where he remained for forty days and nights. His vision is recalled at Jesus' Transfiguration, accompanied by Peter, James and John, the "eyewitnesses of his majesty." Years later, Peter would recall this momentous experience in his second Epistle. In Epiphany, we followed the Magi, who also saw the glory of God – this time in the person of a small child. Like many others who were not granted these life-changing encounters, we don't need to go climb a mountain or make an arduous journey to find God in his glory. As you move to the altar rail this morning to receive the Body and Blood of Christ, recognise that here YOU are participating in an AWE-some event in which God is truly present to you and the other members of your congregation. You, too, may be transfigured, to show God's glory and goodness to others.

NEWS from the TINGLES, now back in Chiang Mai – “Dear friends, now that we are getting back into regular routines here in Chiang Mai we wanted to give you all a quick update. It was so good to catch up with many of you during our trip back to Australia.

The girls have really enjoyed getting back into school routine, spending time with friends and some extra activities- playing football, dance, singing. **Praise God for this provision for the girls** after a season of uncertainty over the last few years. **A huge need here is for teachers to come at the girls school**, Grace International School - teachers from kindy to 12th grade, teachers' aides, school counsellors, a speech therapist etc..

At the Centre, we have welcomed 4 new staff members in the last 6 weeks. **Thank you for praying for God to provide new teachers.** This is enabling us to cater for more students and we are also planning some new activities to engage with students. **Please pray for us to work together well as a team.**

Please pray for the visa situation for new families coming to volunteer in Thailand. At the moment, they are no longer giving dependent visas for family members. This is affecting one of our new teachers & some of our other friends in the city. Pray for a good solution to this soon.

We are amazed & encouraged by the way that God knows our needs & has continued to provide for us over the years we have been serving cross-culturally. **Can you please join us in praying for our support.** We have been encouraged to have a couple of new supporters & some current supporters were able to increase their support. However, **we are still \$1000 a month short on our regular support.** (New support forms are available on ST Paul's Prayer Table.) A full copy of their Letter, with photos, is on Notice Board.
