- 1) The new Archbishop of Jerusalem, the Right Rev'd Hosam Naoum, has called for **donations for fuel & medical supplies** for the **Ahli Hospital in Gaza**, which is treating those with severe wounds, including people with moderate to severe burns, in their advanced burns wards. They are also providing support to traumatised women & children.
- 2) **In India**, local ACT partners are **supporting people who are sick at home or quarantined**, by providing them with cash to buy medicines & other emergency needs.
