ABM Pew Sheet Reflection 2019: “As a farmer’s son I have always felt some affinity with Amos (who told us in last Sunday’s reading that he was a farmer, not a professional prophet). The sorts of things he strongly condemned – dirty tricks, sharp practices, scams, shady deals, profits before people, are sadly still very much around today – also the misuse of power, ‘destroying slanders’, hurtful words and deceit mentioned in today’s Psalm. We need to take time regularly to listen to Jesus (as Mary did), including checking out any ways we are falling short of God’s standard of love, and repent accordingly.”
