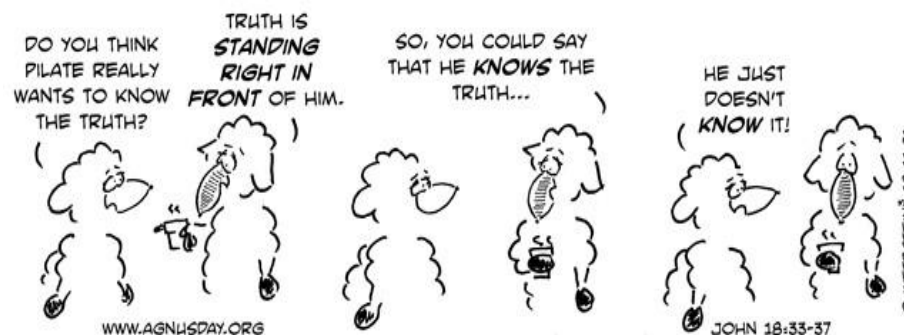

- **Rev'd Tim thanks everyone** for their help & support, "*it is impossible for one person to meet all the needs of the parish, and I am so grateful to be ably assisted by all of you, and the ministry team,*" he says.
- **Tim & Annemarie will likely take some time off** in January, & will attend a Couples Retreat paid for by the Diocese, in February.
- **Tim has asked Bp Mark to preside & preach** on January 16 when he is here to install Rev'd John Thomas in Cobargo Parish.
- P/C agreed unanimously that **St Paul's Hall be the venue for Resonate Church**, on Sunday afternoons. Pastor Clarke & his wife Prudence have supported many of our Parish initiatives, including Messy Church, Mainly Music, Youth Group & etc.
- The **quote for painting the Noble Room** is \$7,200, & with the eaves, fascia etc, total cost is \$12,500. Unknown is the cost of repairs to rotting timbers etc that the work uncovers.
- **Ven Jane advises** that she can hold a Worship Only Service, on Wednesdays at IRT, & visit 1 resident daily. At Estia, it's only 5 people, so Kath will continue there, we thank you Kath!
- All Saints **Memorial Garden** concreting should be completed soon, at cost of \$2,640.
- All Saints is now **open daily** to the general public.
