

The Psalmist knows that God is far beyond us in every way, and so his response is: ‘*O satisfy us early with your mercy, that all our days we may rejoice and sing*’. He knows we need God’s mercy because without it there would be no prospect of rejoicing. May God always extend mercy to us, for without it we would perish.
