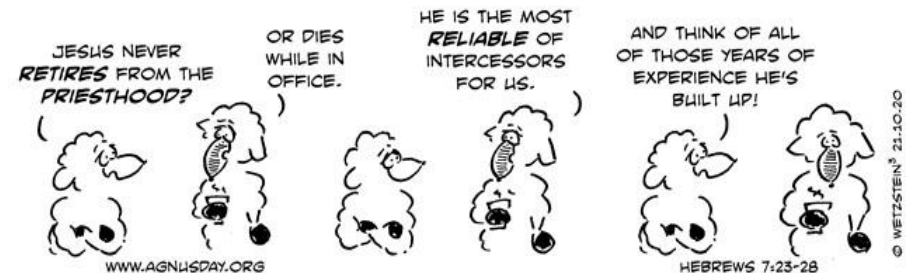

- Selva & Juliat, Lawrence & Marya's Court Appeal: “... rather than make a ruling on the spot, which he could have done, the judge said that he would carefully go over the depositions & evidence and make a decision in the next few weeks... Their lawyer said in an email after proceedings: “...My guess would be that it will take a few weeks, but it can take months.... It's a good sign that the Court will take some time and give us a written judgment. It means that His Honour will carefully think about all the points raised before making a decision... We feel that (the Judge) was genuinely concerned for the family.”
