LATEST UPDATE from the TINGLES, our Link Missionaries in Thailand:

“Dear friends, Three weeks ago we had new team mates arrive from South Africa to join us at The Centre. They have previously served long term in another Asian country, so bring with them experience & knowledge that makes the transition easier & means they can jump in quickly. We are enjoying getting to know them & their 4 kids who are similar ages to ours. The girls are a month into their 3-month summer holidays. They have been spending hours each day building lego towns, skateboarding & playing ultimate frisbee at the park.

*Covid cases have settled down in Chiang Mai thankfully, but it is still getting worse every week in Bangkok & other areas. With no domestic travel restrictions it feels like it's only a matter of time before we have another spike. Vaccines are finally being rolled out now, but we're not sure how long we will have to wait. At the moment there are two options- over 60's and those with health conditions get Astrazeneca, but everyone else is getting the Chinese Sinovac. It is not recognised in Australia yet, so we need to consider what to do if we want to be able to return on furlough at some point. **Please PRAY for wisdom & God's provision.***

*The Centre is still closed because of Covid, but we are planning to open again in July. **Please PRAY** for us to be able to start some new classes & for good opportunities to connect with the students.*

***Please PRAY** the Covid situation in Thailand to improve & for vaccines to be available soon.*

***PRAY** for the girls as they've had to say some hard goodbyes lately.*

***PRAISE God** that we have some new staff arriving to work at The Centre.*

This from Bishop Carol:

I know this is highly inconvenient, and very short notice, but new Covid restrictions have been imposed for regional NSW which will affect tomorrow's worship services.

From the ABC website: Regional NSW COVID-19 restrictions explained

New social distancing restrictions are being imposed on regional NSW in response to the state's growing COVID-19 outbreak. All regional areas are affected, except the Central Coast, Blue Mountains and Wollongong — which are already subjected to a stricter lockdown. From 6:00pm today until 11:59pm on Friday, July 9, the following restrictions apply in all other parts of NSW:

- *Visitors to households will be limited to 5 guests — including children;*
- *Masks will be compulsory in all indoor non-residential settings, including workplaces, and at organised outdoor events;*
- *Drinking while standing at indoor venues will not be allowed;*
- *Singing by audiences and choirs at indoor venues or by congregants at indoor places of worship will not be allowed;*
- *Dancing will not be allowed at indoor hospitality venues or nightclubs however, dancing is allowed at weddings for the wedding party only (no more than 20 people);*
- *Dance and gym classes limited to 20 per class (masks must be worn);*
- *The one person per 4 square metre rule will be re-introduced for all indoor and outdoor settings, including weddings and funerals; Outdoor seated, ticketed events will be limited to 50 per cent seated capacity;*

Premier Gladys Berejiklian told people in NSW not to panic buy essentials, and said they shouldn't be scared.

She said the number of COVID-19 cases in her state would go up over the next few days. "So I just want everybody to brace themselves and not to be scared because we're taking the right advice, we're doing the right things," she said.
