- 4 "You walked in there (Asbury University Revival, Feb 2023) and you heard just chorus after chorus of everyone there joining in singing together (Jon Snyder, filmmaker.)
- ♣ What the Holy Spirit was doing en masse to so many people there were college students, some weeping, some joyfully laughing... God was moving and touching the hearts and lives of people, and that's what I saw."
- ♣ 'You heard so much about unity. The students were just driven into unity.... So many people experienced a heart transformation during the time...'
- # "It feels like to me that God is moving, that God is stirring His people, and the people are responding – they're hungry. So it feels like this is the precursor... But I feel like it's the start of something.
- ♣ The main take-home lesson is this: the need for God's people to come together in unity to worship him.... God's people were coming together just for the sole purpose of worshipping him and God was pouring out his Spirit indiscriminately on people. People there from all different denominations.
