ABM NEWS: "In 2023, across four countries (Kenya, Myanmar, Philippines, Solomon Islands), **AID projects** helped more than **6,400 people** to gain access to agricultural technologies. These included soil and water conservation approaches, seed selection and storage, and making organic fertilisers and pesticides.
