

WEDDING FEES

RECOMMENDED MINIMUM DONATION is \$800.00

This includes the interview, marriage preparation sessions, rehearsal and provision of a priest for the wedding ceremony, registration of the marriage with Births , Deaths & Marriages, the church use fee and travel costs.

Marriage Preparation with the celebrant utilises a questionnaire from an organisation called Prepare-Enrich. There is a charge from this organisation of \$42.00, payable online when the couple registers for the questionnaire.

Where Marriage Preparation is completed outside the parish, there will be a reduction of \$100.00 in the above amount.

The legal certificate of marriage is by law no longer able to be provided by the parish. It needs to be ordered by the couple from the Registry of Births, Deaths & Marriages. The paperwork for the marriage certificate can be submitted by the priest along with the registration papers following the marriage if required, which eliminates the need for the couple to go through the identification process a second time with B D & M. The cost of the marriage certificate is as follows:

Cost of certificates	\$AUD
Standard marriage certificate. Add \$26 for Priority processing.	\$56
Commemorative package (includes standard certificate). Add \$26 for Priority processing.	\$81

All certificates are distributed through Registered Post and include postage and handling. However, this does not ensure next day delivery.

DEPOSIT:

A \$100 deposit is required to book your wedding date, which is deducted from the total fee. All remaining fees should be finalised with the Church office 2 weeks prior to the rehearsal.
