Confirmation of date

Interview

An interview needs to be arranged with the celebrant at least three months prior to the wedding. At this interview, the Notice of Intended Marriage form and an application for your Marriage Certificiate needs to be completed, *original birth certificates* of each partner, and *photo ID* sighted. If not a first marriage, the *decree absolute* (certificate of divorce) is also required.

Music & rehearsal

Music needs to be in keeping with the occasion. The church sound system will take CDs or can amplify a phone or ipod. Live musicians are also welcome.

If you would like the historic Willis pipe organ for your wedding, contact details of the organist can be provided. Arrangements with the organist are separate, and do not form part of the wedding fee.

The rehearsal is normally scheduled the evening before the wedding. It is recommended that the Bridal Party, the person 'giving away' the bride and any readers attend, and the music be available.

A document called "the Final Declarations" also needs to be signed by the bride & groom at the rehearsal.

Two ushers to show people to their seats, someone to operate the recorded music (if used) and someone to ring the bell as the bride and groom depart from the Church is also recommended for the wedding day.

Please finalise the balance of your payment 2 weeks prior to the rehearsal.

May this time of preparation for your wedding be one of blessing and growth!
